Dear Parents,

We are pleased to inform you that we are holding a Transition Day on Monday 26 June for all our Year 8 boys joining the Upper School and for external boys joining Year 9 in September. The purpose of the day is for the boys to familiarise themselves with the Upper School, to spend time with their Housemaster and other boys joining the House and to take part in various team building activities.

We hope that, by the end of the day, friendship groups will have formed and that the boys may exchange contact details and perhaps be in touch with each other over the summer break.

All boys are asked to wear mufti on the day and lunch will be provided for them in the dining halls.

Please could your son make his way to the Café Bar on arrival at school (but not before 8.30am) where breakfast will be provided and all of the Upper School Housemasters will be in attendance. Once all the external boys have arrived, everyone will be taken to the Theatre for a welcome talk. We would like to invite you to join your son, along with the rest of his House, for tea in the House Tents which will be situated in front of the Langham Pavilion. Tea will be served from 3.20pm and it is anticipated that the event will finish by 4.00pm. If you are not attending and your son is to return home in the normal way on a school coach, he will need to make his way to the coach pickup point at the end of the day.

We will assume that all Prep School boys will be attending the day (please note that there will be no Year 8 classes taking place that day).
