

Y8 Geography Field Visit along the Great Ouse

8V and 8M, Friday 9th June 8.55-11.55am.

8S, 8J, 8N, Friday 16th June 8.55-11.55am.

As part of the Geography lessons on River Management after half term, there is a planned fieldtrip looking at these features. The boys will travel by coach to Riverfield and then to Priory Country Park. They will then be escorted along the Great Ouse as we walk back to school along the Embankment observing these manmade features. They will be back at school for lunch and the subsequent afternoon lessons and activities.

- The boys should be in school uniform and will not require any specialist equipment other than decent walking shoes- school shoes are adequate.
- They may bring electronic devices for photographing the river features, but they will be responsible for these.
- They will also need a writing pen and pencil so as to complete the fieldwork activities in the booklets provided on the morning of the fieldtrip.

If boys have other lessons/ paid activities booked for that morning they must try to rearrange these and they must let their Geography teacher know if they are not attending the fieldtrip.

We often need a few parents to assist with the supervision of the Y8 boys and if you could help from 8.55am to 12 noon, for either the first field trip on Fri 9th June or the second field trip on Fri 16th June, then we would be most grateful.
