Re: School trip to St. Omer, France

Dear Parents,

Your son has expressed an interest in joining the French Department Trip to St. Omer from Friday 15th December 2017 to Monday 18th December 2017. This is a residential trip and boys will be travelling by coach and Channel Tunnel to St. Omer.

An essential part of learning a language is also having the opportunity to explore the culture. This trip will offer your son the opportunity to explore the French culture as well as to develop his language skills. We will be staying at Château Ebblinghem, which is offering full-board accommodation. During the trip we hope to explore the Christmas Market in Lille, spend half a day in Boulogne and visit a WW2 museum. As well as these day trips, we will also be taking part in a crêpe making activity and enjoying a 3 course meal at a local French restaurant.

The trip will cost approximately £355. The package will include travel, full board accommodation, insurance and admission to all activities and visits. In addition, boys will need to take enough pocket money to purchase food and drinks whilst travelling and for souvenirs, if they wish to purchase these. The party will be supervised by at least three members of staff and for the trip to be viable we need a minimum of 32 students.

Students will need to have a valid passport and a European Health Insurance Card (obtainable from https://www.ehic.org.uk/Internet/startApplication.do). Where applicable, please ensure that a valid visa is in place for a visit to France. EU Passport holders do not need a visa.

I would be grateful if a deposit of £100 could be received by Friday 16th June 2017. The balance (£255) will then be payable by Monday I Ith September 2017. Cheques should be made payable to Bedford School Trust Central bank and sent to me at the school.

I look forward to writing to you again with the exact itinerary, details of the transport and the accommodation.
