A Note for those boys eligible for Extra Time in Exams:

Boys with extra time in exams may find that they have some long days of internal exams with very short break times. This can happen in the GCSEs themselves, and is beyond the School's control; the Trial exams therefore give boys a valuable opportunity to experience this and develop coping strategies as they prepare for the actual GCSE exams.

Where the total duration of written exams in one day is more than five and a half hours including extra time, boys have the option to take one of those exams on a different day (as is the case in the actual GCSEs). Boys who are in this situation are indicated in green in the above timetable and will be contacted by the Head of Academic Support to let them know about their revised exam timetables.

Please note: eligible boys must use the full arrangements in the Trial Exams, and will not be permitted to leave an exam early if they have extra time. This is because if they do not make full use of their eligible time, they will lose it for their actual GCSEs as the School has to provide evidence to exam boards of arrangements being used as the normal way of working in the School.
