As I am sure you are aware, boys in Y6 have been studying the Tudor era. To conclude their work, the whole year group will be enjoying a day immersed in the life of a working Tudor manor.

Sulgrave Manor is widely recognised as one of the country's leading educational sites for exploring Tudor life – enabling the visitor to travel back in time. During this trip, Tudor reenactors will transform the site into a living museum for visiting school groups. The boys will take a journey through the estate. Amongst other things they will have the chance to assist in daily chores, participate in workshops and watch Tudor entertainment. It promises to be an excellent learning experience.
