The Hungry Boys' Club is a cookery club where pupils will learn how to cook different recipes and take their food home with them. It will be run by the chefs in the dining halls at school and supervised by a member of staff, Nicki Carrington. It will be a three week course.

This club will take place in the Café Bar in the School Dining Halls on Tuesdays from 4.10 – 5.30 pm beginning the last week in September, Tuesday 25th September and continuing on the 9th and 16th of October.

The ingredients that will be required for each session are provided by the Catering Department in order to ensure traceability, and the total cost for the sessions will be £12.00.

All participants must bring a large tupperware container to the sessions to take home their prepared dishes. Some dishes will be cooked on site, whilst others may need to be finished at home.
