This term our Y4 boys will have an opportunity to participate in a Science and team building trip to the school's nature reserve site at Ickwell Bury. The trip will be led by Mrs Russell who is a trained Forestry Schools Teacher. Ms Valentino, Miss Oakley and I will also be on the trip.

Details are as follows:

Destination: Ickwell, Bedfordshire

Date: Friday 28th September 2018

Depart: 9.00am. Boys should come to school at normal time for registration

Return: Before 4.00pm, for normal end of afternoon school time

Wear and bring: Layers of thin clothing (vests, T-shirts, jumpers etc)

Long trousers and long sleeves to protect from scratches etc

Wellington boots or walking boots

Waterproof and windproof coat (and ideally trousers too)

Hat (without dangly ties), gloves and thick socks

Ruck sack

Drink and snacks

Spare trousers and socks

Any necessary medication

Sunhats and sun cream (depending on weather)

NB. Clothing does not need to be school branded

Cost: Funded by Bedford Prep School

The boys will undertake a number of exciting activities that are designed to build new friendships and develop confidence by utilising the great outdoors, and also link to their future Science studies of plants.
