

PUPIL CODE OF CONDUCT

You must

- not take unnecessary risks
- follow the instructions of the group leaders and other supervisors
- dress and behave sensibly and responsibly at all times
- show courtesy at all times, but particularly when dealing with members of the public; respecting the host country and their culture
- be punctual at all times, including bedtime
- always wear a seat belt on the coach and ensure that bags do not obstruct aisles. You will be told about emergency doors, escape hammers and first-aid kits on the coach — you must be aware of these at all times
- carry identity cards/hotel information with you at all times
- behave courteously and sensibly if approached by anyone you do not know; on no account should you antagonise or provoke them or be led by them into illegal activities or put yourself in a position of potential danger. Walk away; alert a member of staff or other members of the tour party. Always think carefully about how your individual actions might affect the group as a whole.
- stay together with your designated group during sightseeing and all other times when you are not directly supervised. Members of a group are responsible for each other at all times. No pupil should ever be on their own.

Under no Circumstances

- purchase or otherwise acquire alcohol unless it is under direct supervision of the group leaders during a meal for instance.
- smoke or take drugs of any category
- bring through customs any alcohol, tobacco, drugs, flick-knives, or fireworks (even as presents for others)

I will show respect for others by

- being conscious of noise level especially at night
- not using language or behaving in a manner that may cause offence to anyone else
- respecting other's property

If there is any other significant violation of the school rules, the group leaders reserve the right to consider sending the pupil home, at the parents' expense.
