

Dear Parents,

Year 5 Pantomime Trip to see Robin Hood – Wednesday 12th December - Final Arrangements

We are thoroughly looking forward to our trip to see Robin Hood at the Milton Keynes theatre with Year 5. 'Oh no you're not,' I hear you cry, but we most definitely are! We will leave school at 11.30 to arrive in time for the performance and the boys will have a packed lunch to eat on the coach. We will be eating ice-cream at the interval, so there is no need for the boys to bring any money.

The theatre has stated that the performance is expected to finish at 3.30. It is a little difficult to predict our exact time of arrival back at school owing to traffic, but we expect to return at about 4.30 approximately. This means that your son may not be back in time to catch a bus. Please can you ensure that he is aware of his travel arrangements? Boys being collected from the theatre will wait in the entrance foyer. If they are not collected, they will be taken back to school. Thank you to those of you who have completed the [form](#). Boys will stay in school uniform and should leave their bags and belongings in their tutor rooms or on their pegs overnight. They will not have Prep that night. They will not need to bring a coat as they are dropped off and collected outside the theatre.

It is essential that if your son has an Epipen or an inhaler that he takes it with him to the theatre. Boys will be allowed to bring their mobile phones so that they can let you know if the coach is delayed. They will not need electronic games.
