GENERAL INFORMATION

Boys must register with House Masters at the stadium at both 1.30pm and 3.45pm. They should remain together in house areas of and support as a house when not competing. No boy should leave before 3.45. All boys then to walk back along prescribed route (with 'buddy' if applicable).

To encourage participation, each boy can enter a maximum of one track event, plus one field event plus the relay.

All competitors must wear the house identification (provided) on the front of their vests/shirts.

Blue school **PE T-SHIRT or Athletics SINGLET, WHITE SHORTS AND WHITE SHORT SOCKS** must be worn by all competitors. Boys in the incorrect kit will not be permitted to compete. This will be at the discretion of the race starter - BJB.

Track events take priority over field events. As such, boys should register at Field events at the start time. If required, boys should then excuse themselves to take part in track events. On completion of their track event, they must return immediately to complete their field event.

EVENT SCORING

There will be competition points for each of the following age groups; **Fourth, Remove, Fifth and Sixth Form** (L6th and U6th combined) with both A and B streams in each age group competition.

In each Sports Day event and stream the following competition points will be awarded: 1st = 6pts / 2nd = 5pts / 3rd = 4pts / 4th = 3pts / 5th = 2pts / 6th = 1pt. **Failure to field a competitor in any event will score zero points in that event. 4x100m Relays score double points.** These are not house points they are used to determine position of the houses on the day. The points will be totaled for each event by age group to determine results.

SAFETY

Boys must **only enter the track via the Briefing Pen** (the paved area in front of the stand) and should report to the member of staff immediately prior to their race.

The **infield area is out of bounds** to all boys except those actively competing in events. Please can all staff, in particular House Masters, be vigilant and remind boys of this during the event.

Please listen to announcements for races and ensure that boys make their way to the pen in plenty of time.
