

Y4 Trip to St Albans Cathedral

Dear Parents

We are organising a trip to St Albans for boys in Year 4 on Monday 11th November 2019.

To bring to life this term's Year 4 Romans topic, we will be taking the boys to the old Roman town of St Albans (known in Roman times as Verulamium). The boys will take part in a Roman trail at the Cathedral and learn about the Romans through role play and experiential activities in small groups. Using the Cathedral as the setting, the boys will dress up to re-enact the story of Alban, saint and martyr. Along the way they will learn about the history of every day Roman life in Verulamium. After looking at some of the mosaics from Verulamium, the boys will also take part in a Mosaic Workshop and design and make their own Mosaic tile to take back to school.

We will depart school by bus at about 9.00am and be back around 3.30pm. The teachers accompanying the trip will be Mr Maitland, Ms Valentino and Miss Oakley.

The entire cost of the trip is being covered by the school, including return coach travel, lunch, entrance fee and workshops.

Boys should wear normal school uniform for the trip and should bring a coat. They are also advised to bring a water bottle.
