Basic Roman costume (everyone will need this)



- A large white t-shirt (needs to reach at least to his knees, one of Dad's old white tees would be perfect!)
- White PE shorts (to wear under t-shirt)
- A Cord (piece of string) or a belt to tie round the waist
- We will be performing barefooted

If anyone has anything at all Scottish (be it a novelty hat with hair etc..... which can be popped on VERY quickly for our final song) fantastic! However, it must be able to be put on in great haste!
