

## Study Leave Arrangements for Summer 2020 Public Exams

The Study Leave Dates for boys in the Fifth Form and Upper Sixth Form are confirmed as follows:

Upper Sixth IB Boys	last day in lessons Tuesday 28 April	Study Leave starts Wednesday 29 April
Fifth Form Boys	last day in lessons Tuesday 5 May	Study Leave starts Wednesday 6 May (NB Bank Holiday Exeat has moved)
Upper Sixth A Level Boys	last day in school Wednesday 13 May	Study Leave starts Thursday 14 May

**All Upper Sixth boys are expected to attend Final Assembly on the afternoon of Friday 3 July; Fifth Form boys are welcome to attend if they wish although they are not expected to do so.**

**All Upper Sixth boys are expected to attend Prize Giving on the morning of Saturday 4 July; Fifth Form boys are welcome to attend if they wish although are not expected to do so. There is a Leavers' Service for Upper Sixth boys prior to Prize Giving on Saturday 4 July.**

The exceptions to this are:

GCSE Art March	who have exams from 8.30 am – 12.45 pm on Friday 20, Monday 23 and Tuesday 24
A Level Art	who have exams from 8.30 am – 12.45 pm on Monday 27, Tuesday 28, Wednesday 29 April and Friday 1 May
IGCSE German	who have exams from 9.00 am Wednesday 29 April and who are therefore entitled to Study Leave on the afternoon of Tuesday 28 April
IGCSE ESL	who have exams on from 1.30 pm on Monday 4 May and Wednesday 6 May and who are therefore entitled to Study Leave mornings of these days

Sixth Form boys taking **Modern Languages Oral Examinations** on the following dates are entitled to Study Leave on the day of their exam, and should return to lessons after the Oral Exam. Fifth Form boys are excused lessons only for their actual exam and the preparation time allowed immediately prior to the exam.

IGCSE Modern Languages	from Tuesday 3 March
IB Languages B	from Thursday 27 February
A Level Modern Languages	from Thursday 30 April

### Notes:

1. Throughout Study Leave, teaching staff will be available to boys for help should they request it; they should contact teachers directly to arrange times. There will also be a schedule of subject-specific revision classes during Study Leave, which will be published in March.
2. Boys are expected to attend instrumental music lessons, Mandarin lessons, EAL lessons, Academic Support lessons, and to fulfil any Games or Team commitments throughout Study Leave unless arrangements are made in advance with the master in charge.
3. Fifth Form boys, especially, are strongly encouraged to use the time available after their exams to arrange work experience.
4. Results Days: IB2 results will be published on Monday 6 July (am); A Level results on Thursday 13 August (am); GCSE/IGCSE results on Thursday 20 August (am). Further details on the arrangements for results days will be published in the Summer Term.
