This letter is to inform you that the Geography department at Bedford Preparatory School is planning a trip for the Y6 boys to Stibbington Day Centre on Tuesday 17th March 2020. We will aim to leave school at 8.45am and return at 4pm.

As I am sure you are aware, the boys have been learning about rivers and flooding in Geography. The trip to Stibbington will involve an examination of river models and practical primary data collection at a tributary of the River Nene.
