

SELLING ITEMS THROUGH THE NEARLY NEW SHOP

- Items must be laundered and in excellent condition and should meet the following criteria;
 - The Shop will only accept items that are described in the official list of School uniform or is usual equipment (such as a cricket bat). The only school shirts that can be accepted are branded “Banner”. Any other brand of shirt (eg: M&S, John Lewis, Next) will be donated to charity. We are not accepting school trousers or any footwear at present.
 - Please do not donate or sell tailored items.
 - If any clothes are dirty, in poor condition will be thrown away.
 - If you would not buy the item, the likelihood is others won't want it either.
- Each item must have a label using the [Nearly New Shop Labels](#) which are then attached with a safety pin.
- A [Seller's Form](#) must be completed and included with the items.
- All name tapes must be removed.
- **During this period of Covid-19 restrictions**, individual arrangements must also be made for drop-off of donations and sale items. Please email guildshop@bedfordschool.org.uk to make an arrangement. The easiest time to drop off is likely to be when the shop is open for sales' appointments.

Terms of sale

Our terms of sale are currently under review and will be made available to view as soon as possible. Substantially, they are as set out above and in addition specify that where an item is sold on your behalf within 2 years of the date it was handed in for sale, you will receive up to 50% of the sale proceeds. After that time, if the item has not been sold, the Guild may dispose of your item as it sees fit, which includes keeping it for an indefinite period, selling it and retaining all of the proceeds for the Guild as well as, alternatively, giving the item to a third party charity. The Guild is not able to return items to you after they have been handed in for sale. Currently, sale proceeds for each parent seller are calculated once per year and, as soon as practicable thereafter, payments are remitted by BACS to the account details specified on the Seller's Form.

Please note: any item left at the Shop without your personal details label or without an accompanying Seller's Form or which is still name-taped will be treated as a donation to the Guild and will not be treated as a sale on your behalf.
