



Dear Fifth Form Parents and Guardians,

Sixth Form and Careers Planning Interviews

As part of your son's Sixth Form and Careers planning, he will be having an interview with one of the Head Master, the Vice Master, the Assistant Head (Teaching and Learning), the Director of IB, or me before the end of term. These interviews will start on Monday 30 November and are designed to explore your son's initial thoughts about career options, and we will work backwards towards the current choices which face him for the Sixth Form. This, we hope, will enable us to do all we can as a school to help him achieve his short-, medium- and long-term goals.

We are aware that not all of the boys will know yet what they want to do later on in life - that is fine, of course - but we would be grateful if they (and you) could give the following some thought in the coming week before they have their interview, so that we can make best use of this initial conversation.

- What would you (/might you) like to be doing when you are 25?
- What would you (/might you) like to do at university?
- What are your favourite subjects currently, and how do you think you will fare at GCSE in these?
- What are your main co-curricular interests?
- Which subjects are you considering studying next year?

The boys themselves will also be contacted with these questions. In addition, boys should use the feedback from their recent Morrisby profiling and interviews to assist with their decisions for the Sixth Form.

Please note that your son will be committing to nothing in these interviews; however, we will be using the content of these interviews to start our curriculum planning for next year (and beyond).
