Zoom Adjudication & Results

There will be a Zoom call for performers of several classes at once and the Adjudicator, hosted by two members of the Festival Committee. **These calls will take place during the evenings of 8th – 12th March.** We will be sending out a separate email to you later this week about this which will include the links to the Zoom call and information on how to join the call. Should you not be able to attend the Zoom adjudication, please let the Festival Secretary know via email: Alexandra Smith: festival@bedfordshirefestival.org.uk and if permission by all participants is granted, then a video recording of the Zoom adjudication will be sent to you.

Mark sheets will be available for entrants following the Zoom adjudications, and Certificates for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places along with medals for the winners will be posted out to School before the end of the March.

Please note that 1st, 2nd and 3rd places for each class will be published on the Festival Facebook, Twitter and Festival website home page the day after the Zoom adjudication has taken place for that class.

If permission is granted by the performer (or parent/guardian if under 13) and the appropriate copyright permission has been granted to the Festival, a selection of performance videos will be shared on the Festival website throughout the week. The links to these will be shared on our Facebook and Twitter pages also. It will unfortunately not be possible to feature all videos with permission granted due to licencing requirements and website capacity.

We are extremely proud of every single one of the boys for their hard work preparing for the festival, especially under such unusual circumstances and we would like to thank you for your continued support.
